Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 1945 as the 138th Ordnance Service Detachment

Reorganized and redesignated 8 April 1945 as the 138th Ordnance Bomb Disposal Squad

Inactivated 30 October 1945 at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland

Redesignated 22 January 1951 as the 38th Explosive Ordnance Disposal Squad and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 24 March 1951 at Raritan Arsenal, New Jersey

Reorganized and redesignated 15 June 1954 as the 38th Ordnance Detachment

Reorganized and redesignated 16 June 1977 as the 38th Ordnance Company
