Redesignated 10 February 1947 as the 512th Ordnance Heavy Automotive Maintenance Company

Activated 10 January 1949 at Fort Bliss, Texas

Redesignated 1 April 1954 as the 512th Ordnance Company

Reorganized and redesignated 1 January 1966 as the 512th Maintenance Company

Inactivated 30 June 1971 in Korea


