Activated 15 August 1944 in France

Redesignated 10 April 1945 as Headquarters, 3057th Ordnance Service Company

Inactivated 12 November 1945 in Belgium

Activated 15 December 1946 in Japan

Redesignated 30 June 1947 as the 592d Ordnance Service Company

Inactivated 15 March 1950 in Japan

Redesignated 24 November 1967 as the 592d Ordnance Company and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 10 January 1968 at Billings, Montana

Ordered into active military service 27 January 2003 at Billings, Montana; released from active military service 25 January 2005 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 11 September 2010 at Billings, Montana; released from active military service 15 October 2011 and reverted to reserve status
