Reorganized and redesignated 4 November 1942 as the 3422d Ordnance Medium Maintenance Company

Reorganized and redesignated 14 June 1943 as the 3422d Ordnance Medium Automotive Maintenance Company

Inactivated 25 April 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 21 January 1955 as the 663d Ordnance Company

Activated 10 March 1955 in Germany

Inactivated 15 June 1993 in Germany


