Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 1 August 1942 as Company C, 71st Ordnance Battalion

Redesignated 4 November 1942 as the 3423d Ordnance Medium Maintenance Company

Reorganized and redesignated 14 June 1943 as the 3423d Ordnance Medium Automotive Maintenance Company

Inactivated 3 May 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 10 March 1955 as the 664th Ordnance Company and activated at Fort Dix, New Jersey


