Inactivated 21 November 1945 in England

Redesignated 19 April 1951 as the 58th Ordnance Antiaircraft Artillery Maintenance Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 May 1951 at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Maryland

Reorganized and redesignated 13 February 1952 as the 58th Ordnance Armament Maintenance Detachment

Reorganized and redesignated 29 June 1954 as the 27th Ordnance Detachment

Inactivated 20 December 1957 at Neville Island, Pennsylvania

Activated 14 December 1959 at Tooele Army Depot, Utah

Reorganized and redesignated 16 June 1997 as the 707th Ordnance Company
