Activated 7 January 1951 at Raritan Arsenal, New Jersey

Reorganized and redesignated 22 January 1951 as the 56th Explosive Ordnance Disposal Squad and allotted to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 23 June 1954 as the 56th Ordnance Detachment

Reorganized and redesignated 16 June 1997 as the 756th Ordnance Company
