Redesignated 22 January 1951 as the 63d Explosive Ordnance Disposal Squad and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 4 February 1952 at Raritan Arsenal, New Jersey

Redesignated 22 June 1954 as the 63d Ordnance Detachment

Reorganized and redesignated 16 June 1997 as the 763d Ordnance Company
