Redesignated 23 Mar 1921 as the 84th Ordnance Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Redesignated 14 December 1942 as the 84th Ordnance Depot Company

Inactivated 15 December 1946 at Yokohama, Japan

Redesignated 23 February 1954 as the 84th Ordnance Company and activated at Pusan, Korea

Inactivated 2 May 1955 at Pusan, Korea

Activated 20 September 1992 at Camp Ames, Korea
