310th PSYCHOLOGICAL OPERATIONS COMPANY

Constituted 17 April 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 1st Mobile Radio Broadcasting Company

Activated 19 April 1943 at Camp Ritchie, Maryland

Inactivated 10 November 1945 in Italy

Redesignated 4 October 1961 as the 10th Psychological Warfare Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 15 November 1961 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 20 December 1965 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Redesignated 30 October 1975 as the 10th Psychological Operations Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Regular Army, allotted to the Army Reserve, and activated at Forest Park, Georgia

Reorganized and redesignated 16 June 1996 as the 310th Psychological Operations Company

Ordered into active military service 10 September 2002 at Forest Park, Georgia; released from active military service 9 September 2003 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 22 February 2006 at Forest Park, Georgia; released from active military service 31 May 2007 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 6 June 2009 at Forest Park, Georgia; released from active military service 10 July 2010 and reverted to reserve status


