Constituted 1 October 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 1st Broadcast Station Operating Detachment

Activated 5 October 1942 at Camp Pickett, Virginia

Inactivated 15 October 1945 in Italy

Redesignated 19 January 1962 as the 21st Psychological Warfare Detachment and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 12 February 1962 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 20 December 1965 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Redesignated 28 October 1966 as the 21st Psychological Operations Detachment

Activated 2 January 1967 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 1 January 1968 in Vietnam

Activated 5 November 1968 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 1 December 1969 in Vietnam

Redesignated 30 October 1975 as the 21st Psychological Operations Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Regular Army, allotted to the Army Reserve, and activated at Parma, Ohio

Reorganized and redesignated 16 June 1996 as the 321st Psychological Operations Company

Location changed 16 September 2006 to Grand Rapids, Michigan

Elements ordered into active military service 6 June 2009 at Grand Rapids, Michigan;
released from active military service 10 July 2010 and reverted to reserve status


