Constituted 5 January 1968 in the Regular Army as the 40th Psychological Operations Detachment and activated at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 1 December 1969 in Vietnam

Redesignated 16 June 1996 as the 140th Psychological Operations Detachment

Redesignated 18 September 2006 as the 340th Psychological Operations Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve

Activated 17 September 2009 at Garner, North Carolina

Ordered into active military service 26 October and 12 November 2011 at Garner, North Carolina; released from active military service 28 November and 15 December 2012 and reverted to reserve status

Detachment ordered into active military service 26 April 2018 at Garner, North Carolina; released from active military service 4 April 2019 and reverted to reserve status
