Constituted 20 December 1965 in the Regular Army as the 246th Psychological Operations Company

Activated 10 February 1966 in Vietnam

Inactivated 1 January 1968 in Vietnam

Withdrawn 30 October 1975 from the Regular Army and allotted to the Army Reserve; concurrently activated at Columbus, Ohio

Location changed 10 November 1984 to Lockbourne, Ohio; changed 1 April 1989 to Blacklick, Ohio; changed 1 October 1996 to Columbus, Ohio

Reorganized and redesignated 16 June 1996 as the 346th Psychological Operations Company

Ordered into active military service 7 March 2003 at Columbus, Ohio; released from active military service 9 June 2004 and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 6-7 June 2009 at Columbus, Ohio; released from active military service 10-11 July 2010 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 16 September 2010 to Whitehall, Ohio
