Ordered into active Federal service 7 January 1991 at Nashville; released from active Federal service 12 May 1991 and reverted to state control

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1997 as Detachment 1, 133d Public Affairs Detachment

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 2006 as the 118th Public Affairs Detachment

Ordered into active Federal service 13 February 2016 at Nashville; released from active Federal service 18 March 2017 and reverted to state control
