Activated 11 October 1955 at Greenwood, South Carolina

Reorganized and redesignated 30 September 1958 as the 319th Public Information Detachment

Inactivated 15 October 1958 at Greenwood, South Carolina

Activated 1 February 1972 at Clemson, South Carolina

Location changed 15 May 1972 to Raleigh, North Carolina

Reorganized and redesignated 1 October 1976 as the 316th Public Affairs Detachment

Location changed 8 February 1977 to Garner, North Carolina

Ordered into active military service 7 December 1990 at Garner, North Carolina; released from active military service 10 May 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 16 October 1993 to Fort Jackson, South Carolina

Ordered into active military service 13 August 1998 at Fort Jackson, South Carolina; later released from active military service and reverted to reserve status

Ordered into active military service 7 February 2003 at Fort Jackson, South Carolina; released from active military service 17 May 2004 and reverted to reserve status
