Constituted 23 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 3001st Ordnance Base Depot Company

Activated 15 March 1943 at the Atlanta Ordnance Depot, Georgia

Inactivated 6 January 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 9 December 1948 as the 209th Ordnance Base Collecting and Transport Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 5 April 1949 at Hammond, Indiana

Inactivated 3 October 1950 at Hammond, Indiana

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 5 November 1962 as the 209th Ordnance Company

Activated 31 January 1963 at Lafayette, Indiana

Reorganized and redesignated 31 January 1968 as the 209th Supply Company

Ordered into active military service 27 September 1990 at Lafayette, Indiana; released from active military service 24 June 1991 and reverted to reserve status

Reorganized and redesignated 17 September 1993 as the 209th Quartermaster Company

Ordered into active military service 25 May 2006 at Lafayette, Indiana
