Inactivated 2 January 1952 in Austria

Redesignated 6 September 1955 as the 488th Quartermaster Company; concurrently allotted to the Regular Army and activated at Fort Lee, Virginia

Inactivated 25 September 1956 at Fort Lee, Virginia

Activated 1 December 1958 in Germany

Inactivated 25 September 1961 in Germany

Activated 17 September 1994 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina
