Activated 4 June 1944 at Whittier, Alaska

Reorganized and redesignated 20 June 1946 as the 4219th Quartermaster Salvage Company

Inactivated 21 April 1947 at Fort Richardson, Alaska

Redesignated 1 May 1947 as the 490th Quartermaster Salvage Repair Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 15 May 1947 at Newark, New Jersey

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps)

Inactivated 12 July 1950 at Newark, New Jersey

Redesignated 15 January 1952 as the 490th Quartermaster Reclamation and Maintenance Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Organized Reserve Corps and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 February 1952 at Camp Atterbury, Indiana

Reorganized and redesignated 14 October 1953 as the 490th Quartermaster Company

Inactivated 15 July 1959 at Fort Lee, Virginia

Converted and redesignated 30 March 1966 as the 490th Supply Company

Activated 16 May 1966 at Fort Devens, Massachusetts

Converted and redesignated 15 August 1995 as the 490th Quartermaster Company
