Activated 3 June 1943 at Camp Atterbury, Indiana

Inactivated 2 January 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 15 January 1952 as the 574th Quartermaster Service Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 February 1952 at Fort Devens, Massachusetts

Reorganized and redesignated 20 November 1954 as the 574th Quartermaster Company

Inactivated 1 February 1955 in France

Activated 24 June 1958 in Italy

Inactivated 15 November 1961 in Italy

Activated 23 November 1965 at Fort Lee, Virginia

Converted and redesignated 20 July 1966 as the 574th Supply and Service Company

Inactivated 15 October 1970 in Vietnam
