Redesignated 12 October 1948 as the 673d Quartermaster Service Company and allotted to the Organized Reserve Corps

Activated 22 October 1948 at Charleston, West Virginia

Inactivated 31 January 1950 at Charleston, West Virginia

(Organized Reserve Corps redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Redesignated 7 May 1956 as the 673d Quartermaster Company

Activated 1 June 1956 at Chapmansville, West Virginia

Location changed 15 February 1958 to Logan, West Virginia

Inactivated 20 March 1959 at Logan, West Virginia

Activated 16 October 1984 at Aguadilla, Puerto Rico

Inactivated 30 September 1993 at Aguadilla, Puerto Rico

Activated 16 September 2008 at Dover, Delaware


