728th QUARTERMASTER COMPANY

Constituted 11 February 1943 in the Army of the United States as Company C, 560th Quartermaster Service Battalion

Activated 8 March 1943 at Fort Huachuca, Arizona

Reorganized and redesignated 15 January 1944 as the 4196th Quartermaster Service Company

Inactivated 29 November 1945 at Camp Myles Standish, Massachusetts

Redesignated 2 January 1948 as the 728th Quartermaster Service Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 9 January 1948 at Gary, Indiana

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Ordered into active military service 11 September 1950 at Gary, Indiana

Reorganized and redesignated 15 October 1953 as the 728th Quartermaster Company

Released from active military service 28 May 1954 and reverted to reserve status

Inactivated 14 September 1954 at Gary, Indiana

Activated 1 May 1959 at Waveland, Indiana

Location changed 31 January 1968 to Evansville, Indiana

Inactivated 15 March 1972 at Evansville, Indiana

Activated 17 April 1995 at Arkansas City, Kansas.

Location changed 1 April 1997 to Washington, Missouri; on 16 September 2006 to Fremont, Nebraska


