Constituted 14 November 1945 in the Army of the United States as Headquarters, 4626th Quartermaster Service Company

Activated 27 December 1945 in Germany

Inactivated 27 June 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 23 May 1947 as the 877th Quartermaster Service Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 7 June 1947 at Lumberton, North Carolina

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Location changed 15 July 1948 to Asheville, North Carolina; changed 9 November 1948 to Ahoskie, North Carolina

Ordered into active military service 19 August 1950 at Ahoskie, North Carolina

Reorganized and redesignated 5 September 1951 as the 877th Quartermaster Petroleum Depot Company

Released from active military service 3 December 1954 and reverted to reserve status

Reorganized and redesignated 4 December 1954 as the 877th Quartermaster Company

Inactivated 20 April 1955 at Ahoskie, North Carolina

Activated 15 January 1963 at Charlotte, North Carolina

Inactivated 31 December 1965 at Charlotte, North Carolina Activated 16 September 1995 at Albuquerque, New Mexico (Elements ordered into active military service in support of the War on Terrorism)
