Constituted 9 August 1944 in the Army of the United States as the 4422d Quartermaster Depot Company

Activated 18 August 1944 in France

Inactivated 31 May 1946 in the Philippines

Redesignated 16 June 1947 as the 887th Quartermaster Service Company and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 1 July 1947 at Grand Saline, Texas

Location changed 30 October 1947 to Dallas, Texas

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 30 September 1949 at Dallas, Texas

Redesignated 24 November 1967 as the 887th Supply Company

Activated 15 December 1967 at Sinton, Texas

Reorganized and redesignated 17 September 1993 as the 887th Quartermaster Company

Ordered into active military service 2 January 2003 at Sinton, Texas; released from active military service 13 April 2004 and reverted to reserve status


