Constituted 27 July 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 960th Quartermaster Service Company

Activated 5 August 1943 at Camp Phillips, Kansas

Inactivated 22 January 1946 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Allotted 25 August 1947 to the Organized Reserves

Activated 16 September 1947 at Chattanooga, Tennessee

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Inactivated 31 December 1950 at Chattanooga, Tennessee

Activated 16 October 1997 at Cedar Rapids, Iowa, as the 960th Quartermaster Company

Ordered into active military service in March 2003 at Cedar Rapids, Iowa; released from active military service 6 June 2003 and reverted to reserve status

Location changed 18 September 2005 to Sioux City, Iowa
