Reorganized and redesignated 27 March 1944 as the 24th Signal Light Construction Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 26 June 1944 as the 24th Signal Heavy Construction Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 5 June 1946 as the 169th Signal Heavy Construction Company

Allotted 3 January 1949 to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 22 July 1949 as the 169th Signal Construction Company

Reorganized and redesignated 1 July 1953 as the 169th Signal Company

Inactivated 22 March 1965 at Fort Polk, Louisiana

Activated 25 September 1965 in Germany

Inactivated 13 November 1967 in Germany

Activated 1 July 1974 in Korea


