Reconstituted 6 March 1946 in the Regular Army as the 16th Signal Service Company

Activated 15 April 1946 in Japan

Inactivated 15 July 1949 in Japan

Redesignated 2 November 1950 as the 16th Signal Radio Relay Company

Activated 8 December 1950 at Camp Gordon, Georgia

Reorganized and redesignated 12 March 1953 as the 16th Signal Company


