Constituted 27 March 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 258th Signal Construction Company

Activated 15 May 1942 at Camp Crowder, Missouri

Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1945 as the 258th Signal Light Construction Company

Reorganized and redesignated 22 June 1946 as the 258th Signal Heavy Construction Company

Inactivated 28 December 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 20 October 1950 as the 258th Signal Construction Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 November 1950 at Camp Gordon, Georgia

Redesignated 25 June 1953 as the 258th Signal Company

Inactivated 31 July 1955 in Austria

Activated 8 August 1957 in Korea

Inactivated 15 May 1975 in Korea

Activated 1 February 1980 at Fort Gordon, Georgia

Inactivated 17 October 1992 at Fort Gordon, Georgia

Activated 16 May 2008 at Fort Sill, Oklahoma


