Inactivated 9 November 1945 at Camp Crowder, Missouri

Redesignated 20 October 1950 as the 261st Signal Construction Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 20 November 1950 at Fort Bliss, Texas

Reorganized and redesignated 20 June 1953 as the 261st Signal Company

Inactivated 22 March 1965 at Fort Bliss, Texas

Activated 21 January 1966 at Fort Hood, Texas

Inactivated 26 February 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 1 June 1974 in Germany

Inactivated 15 September 1994 in Germany
