Constituted 11 May 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 268th Signal Construction Company

Activated 1 September 1943 at Camp Crowder, Missouri

Reorganized and redesignated 15 February 1944 as the 268th Signal Heavy Construction Company

Inactivated 9 November 1945 at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey

Redesignated 28 October 1958 as the 268th Signal Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 20 November 1958 at Fort Devens, Massachusetts

Inactivated 22 March 1965 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Activated 25 April 1966 at Fort Huachuca, Arizona

Inactivated 15 January 2003 in Germany

Activated 16 April 2007 at Fort Hood, Texas


