Activated 1 September 1943 at Camp Crowder, Missouri

Reorganized and redesignated 15 February 1944 as the 269th Signal Heavy Construction Company

Inactivated 2 May 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 4 April 1960 as the 269th Signal Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 May 1960 in France

Inactivated 1 July 1967 in Germany

Activated 1 March 1970 in Vietnam

Inactivated 16 January 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 1 June 1974 in Germany

Inactivated 16 September 1990 in Germany

Activated 16 July 1994 at Fort Huachuca, Arizona
