Redesignated 21 January 1955 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 216th Signal Depot, and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 10 March 1955 at Fort Sam Houston, Texas

Inactivated 24 June 1966 at the Sacramento Army Depot, California

Redesignated 15 June 2004 as the 2d Signal Center

Activated 16 October 2005 at Fort Huachuca, Arizona
