HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 30th SIGNAL BATTALION

Constituted 11 May 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 30th Signal Construction Battalion

Activated 17 August 1942 at Camp Atterbury, Indiana

Reorganized and redesignated 14 June 1944 as the 30th Signal Heavy Construction Battalion

(Company A inactivated 1 January 1946 in Italy)

Inactivated (less Company A) 10 June 1946 in Italy

Redesignated 16 October 1992 as the 30th Signal Battalion and allotted to the Regular Army; Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment concurrently activated at Fort Shafter, Hawaii


