Inactivated 15 May 1946 in Japan

Redesignated 27 January 1967 as the 333d Signal Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 25 February 1967 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 30 April 1983 at Fort Gordon, Georgia

Activated 16 October 1992 in Japan
