Activated 1 February 1943 at Camp Pinedale, California

Redesignated 9 June 1943 as the 337th Signal Company, Troop Carrier Wing

Inactivated 10 October 1945 at Camp Kilmer, New Jersey

Redesignated 30 September 1966 as the 337th Signal Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 December 1966 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Inactivated 13 February 1972 in Vietnam

Activated 16 May 2007 at Fort Polk, Louisiana
