HEADQUARTERS AND HEADQUARTERS DETACHMENT 36th SIGNAL BATTALION

Constituted 11 May 1942 in the Army of the United States as the 36th Signal Construction Battalion

Activated 25 May 1943 at Camp Crowder, Missouri

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1944 as the 36th Signal Heavy Construction Battalion

Inactivated 15 June 1946 in Germany

Redesignated 1 March 1963 as the 36th Signal Battalion and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 26 March 1963 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 36th Signal Battalion, reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1970 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 36th Signal Battalion (organic elements concurrently inactivated in Vietnam)

Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 36th Signal Battalion, inactivated 26 August 1971 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 36th Signal Battalion, activated 1 July 1974 in Korea
