Constituted 8 January 1943 in the Army of the United States as the 41st Signal Construction Battalion

Activated 25 January 1943 at Camp Forrest, Tennessee

Reorganized and redesignated 14 May 1945 as the 41st Signal Light Construction Battalion

Inactivated 7 December 1945 in Germany

Redesignated 20 October 1950 as the 41st Signal Construction Battalion and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 13 November 1950 at Camp Rucker, Alabama

Reorganized and redesignated 29 October 1953 as the 41st Signal Battalion

(Companies A, B, C, and D inactivated 1 March 1970 in Vietnam)

Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 41st Signal Battalion, inactivated 27 February 1972 at Fort Lewis, Washington

Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 41st Signal Battalion, redesignated 1 July 1974 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 41st Signal Battalion, and activated in Korea
