Inactivated 25 October 1945 in the Philippines

Redesignated 5 July 1949 as the 504th Signal Base Maintenance Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 7 September 1949 at the Sacramento Signal Depot, California

Reorganized and redesignated 4 October 1954 as the 504th Signal Company

Inactivated 25 June 1966 at the Sacramento Army Depot, California

Activated 1 March 1970 in Vietnam

Inactivated 6 September 1971 in Vietnam

Activated 12 December 1992 in Germany

Inactivated 15 September 1994 in Germany

Activated 16 October 2011 in Germany
