Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 60th Signal Battalion, redesignated 17 March 1972 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 60th Signal Battalion, and activated in Vietnam

Inactivated 29 June 1972 at Oakland, California

Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 60th Signal Battalion, redesignated 16 October 2021 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 60th Signal Battalion; and battalion concurrently activated at Fort Gordon, Georgia
