Inactivated 26 June 1950 in Japan

Redesignated 1 March 1963 as the 62d Signal Battalion

Activated 26 March 1963 at Fort Bragg, North Carolina

Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 62d Signal Battalion, converted, and redesignated 25 April 1966 as Headquarters and Main Support Company, 62d Maintenance Battalion

Inactivated 4 October 1972 at Oakland Army Base, California

Converted and redesignated 1 January 1998 as the 62d Signal Battalion

Activated 17 October 2009 at Fort Hood, Texas
