Inactivated 25 January 1951 in Alaska

Redesignated 9 June 1953 as the 63d Signal Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 1 July 1953 at Fort Monmouth, New Jersey

Inactivated 25 June 1959 at Fort Huachuca, Arizona

Activated 1 March 1970 in Vietnam

Inactivated 16 January 1972 in Vietnam
