Inactivated 20 June 1948 in Germany

Redesignated 5 January 1955 as the 69th Signal Company and allotted to the Regular Army

Activated 24 February 1955 in Germany

Inactivated 1 May 1976 in Germany

Activated 1 October 1981 at Fort Huachuca, Arizona
