Inactivated 25 June 1959 at Camp Gordon, Georgia

Activated 12 August 1963 in France

Inactivated 12 November 1967 in Germany

Activated 1 July 1974 in Korea

Inactivated 16 October 1995 in Korea

Redesignated 27 January 2005 as the 6th Signal Center
