Reorganized and redesignated 26 February 1944 as the 812th Signal Service Company

Inactivated 30 June 1946 in Italy

Redesignated 6 December 1946 as the 812th Signal Depot Company; concurrently withdrawn from the Regular Army and allotted to the Organized Reserves

Activated 17 December 1946 at Wilmington, Delaware

(Organized Reserves redesignated 25 March 1948 as the Organized Reserve Corps; redesignated 9 July 1952 as the Army Reserve)

Reorganized and redesignated 10 November 1948 as the 812th Signal Light Construction Company

Reorganized and redesignated 19 July 1949 as the 812th Signal Construction Company

Inactivated 5 October 1953 at Wilmington, Delaware

Redesignated 4 March 1959 as the 812th Signal Company

Activated 24 April 1959 at Cincinnati, Ohio

Location changed 14 December 1970 to Kings Mills, Ohio
