Lineage and Honors

113th SUPPORT BATTALION

Organized 19 September 1917 in the Indiana and Kentucky National Guard while in Federal service at Camp Shelby, Mississippi, as the 113th Sanitary Train, an element of the 38th Division

Demobilized in February 1919 at Camp Zachary Taylor, Kentucky

Reconstituted in the Indiana and Kentucky National Guard as the 113th Medical Regiment and assigned to the 38th Division; Headquarters Federally recognized 16 February 1923 at Indianapolis, Indiana

113th Medical Regiment inducted into Federal service 17 January 1941 at home stations

Reorganized and redesignated 1 March 1942 as the 113th Medical Battalion, an element of the 38th Infantry Division

Inactivated 9 November 1945 at Camp Anza, California

Reorganized and Federally recognized 2 February 1948 in the Indiana Army National Guard with Headquarters at Lafayette

(Companies C and D allotted 1 December 1967 to the Ohio and Michigan Army National Guard; and re-allotted 1 March 1977 to the Indiana National Guard)

(Location of Headquarters changed 1 April 1978 to Indianapolis)

Converted and redesignated 1 September 1993 as the 113th Support Battalion and remained assigned to the 38th Infantry Division

113th SUPPORT BATTALION

Relieved 1 September 1994 from assignment to the 38th Infantry Division and assigned to the 76th Infantry Brigade

(Location of Headquarters changed 16 April 1995 to Columbus)

Ordered into active Federal service 1 May 2004 at home stations; released from active Federal service 27 October 2005 and reverted to state control

(Location of Headquarters changed 7 November 2007 to Muncie)

Ordered into active Federal service 10 December 2007 at home stations; released from active Federal service 12 January 2009 and reverted to state control
