Constituted 20 November 1967 in the Wisconsin Army National Guard as the 132d Support Battalion and assigned to the 32d Infantry Brigade

Organized and Federally recognized 30 December 1967 from existing units with Headquarters at Madison

Location of Headquarters changed 1 September 2003 to Portage

Relieved 1 September 2008 from assignment to the 32d Infantry Brigade and assigned to the 32d Infantry Brigade Combat Team

Ordered into active Federal service 1 February 2009 at home stations; released from active Federal service 7 March 2010 and reverted to state control

Reorganized 1 September 2017 in the Wisconsin and Michigan Army National Guard, an element of the 32d Infantry Brigade Combat Team
