Converted and redesignated (less Company A) 1 March 1953 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 242d Transportation Battalion (Company A concurrently converted and redesignated as the 548th Transportation Truck Company – hereafter separate lineage)

Converted and redesignated 15 April 1959 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 104th Replacement Battalion

Converted and redesignated 1 April 1963 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 146th Engineer Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 15 January 1968 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 235th Engineer Group

Reorganized and redesignated 1 September 1976 as the 235th Engineer Detachment

Location changed 1 January 1984 to Nevada

Location changed 1 May 1995 to Jefferson City

Ordered into active Federal service 15 March 2003 at Jefferson City; released 7 July 2004 from active Federal service and reverted to state control

Consolidated 1 April 2004 with Detachment 1, 235th Engineer Detachment (organized and Federally recognized 28 January 1998 and 10 February 1998 as Detachments 1 and 2, 235th Engineer Detachment) and consolidated unit designated as the 235th Engineer Detachment

Consolidated 1 September 2006 with the 711th Transportation Detachment (see ANNEX), and consolidated unit designated as Detachment 2, 735th Quartermaster Company

Converted and redesignated 1 October 2010 as the 138th Support Company
