Converted and redesignated 1 August 1942 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 1st Battalion, 57th Ordnance Heavy Maintenance Regiment

Reorganized and redesignated 30 September 1942 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 194th Ordnance Heavy Maintenance Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 1 June 1943 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 194th Ordnance Battalion

Inactivated 30 June 1946 on Luzon, Philippines

Redesignated 27 January 1967 as Headquarters and Main Support Company, 194th Maintenance Battalion

Activated 23 February 1967 at Fort Meade, Maryland

Inactivated 22 May 1968 at Fort Meade, Maryland

Redesignated 1 May 1970 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 194th Maintenance Battalion and activated in Korea

Converted, reorganized, and redesignated 17 October 2006 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 194th Support Battalion
