Organized1 May 1963 from existing units in central Louisiana with Headquarters at Alexandria

Reorganized and redesignated 1 December 1967 as the 199th Support Battalion; concurrently relieved from assignment to the 39th Infantry Division and assigned to the 256th Infantry Brigade

Ordered into active Federal service 30 November 1990 at home stations; released from active Federal service 7 May 1991 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 26 April 2004 at home stations; released from active Federal service 25 November 2005 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 5 January 2010 at home stations; released from active Federal service 8 February 2011 and reverted to state control
