Activated 15 December 1944 at Camp Bowie, Texas

Converted and redesignated 1 August 1946 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 296th Transportation Corps Truck Battalion

Redesignated 31 July 1947 as Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 296th Transportation Truck Battalion

Reorganized and redesignated 17 October 1949 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 296th Transportation Truck Battalion

Allotted 25 October 1951 to the Regular Army

Reorganized and redesignated 8 April 1954 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 296th Transportation Battalion

Inactivated 5 November 1955 in Japan

Redesignated 16 October 1989 as Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 296th Support Battalion, assigned to the 2d Infantry Division, and activated in Korea (organic elements concurrently constituted and activated)

Inactivated 16 September 1992 in Korea

Activated 16 April 1995 at Fort Lewis, Washington
