Ordered into active Federal service 12 October 2003 at home stations; released from active Federal service 8 April 2005 and reverted to state control

Ordered into active Federal service 2 January 2008 at home stations; released from active Federal service 4 February 2009 and reverted to state control

Reorganized 2 September 2016 in the Arkansas and Pennsylvania Army National Guard and remained assigned to the 39th Infantry Brigade Combat Team

Reorganized 1 September 2017 in the Arkansas and Nebraska Army National Guard and remained assigned to the 39th Infantry Brigade Combat Team

Reorganized 1 September 2018 in the Arkansas, Missouri, and Nebraska Army National Guard and remained assigned to the 39th Infantry Brigade Combat Team
